House of Mercy Food Pantry To Remain Open Despite Suspending Donation Center and Thrift Store Operations in Response to COVID-19

Manassas, Virginia - House of Mercy will temporarily be suspending operations in our Thrift Store and Donation Center starting at 12:00pm on Thursday, March 19, 2020. **Our food pantry will remain open as long as possible serving clients and accepting non-perishable food and monetary donations at our food pantry receiving door at the back of our building.** We will continue these operations as long as it's safe to do so, or until any government direction to close. There are still a lot of people depending on us for food to survive.

As we continue to be updated by Health and Government officials, it has become clear that we need to do our part in helping to contain the spread of COVID-19. In addition, we work with many who are more vulnerable to this virus through our food pantry and volunteer programs. Our priority is the safety of all in the House of Mercy family. We appreciate your continued prayers and support through this most difficult and uncertain time. We will be in communication once we can open our donation center and thrift store again.
